Company's network of 1,228 branches (as on August 31, 2019) across 22 states and union territories also helps the clients access easy small ticket loans for solar utilities, water and sanitation, cycle, and many other necessities for life. Through its subsidiaries Taarashna, Satin Housing Finance, and Satin Finserv, the company is adding more dimensions to its core business
